

St Thomas' of Canterbury Primary School

Summary of Parent Questionnaires 2018

Forty-seven questionnaires were returned. Sixteen questionnaires indicated the family had a child in the Early Years, twelve questionnaires indicated the family had a child in Key Stage 1 and twenty questionnaires indicated the family had a child in Key Stage 2. Three questionnaires did not record a stage.

The questionnaire focused on four key areas: Catholic Ethos and Education, Pastoral Care, Academic Provision and School Home Partnership. One question required a free text response and therefore is not tabulated or graphically displayed.

If a parent did not respond to, or selected multiple responses to, a question it was categorised as "Missing/Ambiguous". One response =2.1%
